Star studded nights at Condong



The Big Apple came back to Condong at the July gig, with the much anticipated return of Dan Bolton and his quartet. Ably supported by reeds player Alex Price, bassist Blake Lonie and Lachlan Hawkins on drums, Dan weaved his way happily through his memories of his years in exile in New York's Upper Westside. With a slick vocal style that hung somewhere between Michael Buble and George Washingmachine, Dan played for two hours to an enthralled audience that's already looking forward to his return.



The August gig lit a blowtorch under the last night of winter as two seasoned acts took to the stage. Club stalwarts The Early Birds laid on an impeccable hour of jazz standards before yielding the stage to the hottest blues outfit along the eastern seaboard, The Mojo Webb Band. Mojo himself on guitar, with JB Lewis on bass and Coojee Tims on drums, have been playing together for so long that they share the same musical DNA, and it's coloured deep blue, from the authentic pain of Muddy Waters to the irrepressible bounce of Lionel Hampton.
