
President's Report

There's an old Chinese curse that reads 'May you live in interesting times', and the Tweed Valley has certainly done that in recent years. After a drought followed by bushfires, we endured two years and more of COVID restrictions, and we were just emerging from these when we were hit with a flood of Biblical proportions that left the valley looking like an inland lake, with hundreds homeless and the streets lined with discarded sodden possessions awaiting the garbage trucks.

The Bowlo copped it along with other riverside properties, and the rising water not only overtopped the bar counter, but came close to swamping the optics. They've mounted a valiant recovery operation, but until they can secure the insurance payout and engage local tradies they'll be out of action, and our normal Club venue will be unavailable. This resulted in the loss of our February, March and April gigs, and for our May and June gigs we've been very fortunate to secure a temporary home at the Murwillumbah Golf Club. Further details will be made available by e-mail and poster in due course, or contact Marlene on 0428 323 736.

We've also opted to extend the current membership year to the end of June 2023, and those of you who've already renewed will not be asked for any further payment until then.

Finally, we're required to plan for our next AGM, to be held on 14th July. Nominations for Committee close a month ahead of that, so you have until the middle of June to get them to Secretary Marlene Downing.

A Trio of top local musicians: Harry Lynn, keyboard; Les Kafoa, drums and John Edwards, bass, with two very talented vocalists we've been very lucky to bring to Murwillumbah Golf Club.

George Harvey is a former lead vocalist with the Kinsmen, and Beth Hamilton is a versatile entertainer who has worked with the Issy Dye Show Band, Phil Emmanuel and lots more. They will be singing standards you'll have heard by Sammy Davis Jr, Frank Sinatra, Carmen McRea and many more from that era

This band is a tribute to one of the greatest musicians of mainstream jazz - vibraphonist Milt "Bags" Jackson. The water cleared the bar easily, rolled over kegs, soaked beer cartons, and covered everything with mud. The furniture was destroyed, including the poker machines and computers in the office. Just as they did following Debbie in 2017, the club is working to restore the venue, but it takes time. Carpets have been torn up, a temporary bar organised to keep the locals happy and installing new pokies is a priority to ensure an income.
